Top meet slated in Texas

The top motocross motorcycle racers in the United States will meet Sunday, August 12 at Lake Whitney Cycle Ranch, Whitney, Texas, for a National Championship Motocross race.

All the factory teams and big names in motocross racing will be competing for the \$5,000 purse and national points.

Expected for the Whitney event is Pierre Karsmakers, the Americanized Dutch champion now riding for Yamaha. Completing the 1-2 punch for Yamaha will be California star Tim Hart.

The number one 500 class rider last year, Brad Lackey, will lead the charge for the "Mean Green" Kawasaki team.

He will be joined by the number 3 ranked rider of last year, Wyman Priddy of Fort Worth, Texas. Rounding out

the Kawasaki team will be Jim Weinert, winner of the Tex-AMA series this fall.

HEADING THE Honda hopes will be Los Angeles Super Bowl winner Marty Trips and the Number one 250 class rider in the nation, Gary Jones. Husqvarna will enter their stellar team of Mike Hartwig, Bob Grossi, Billy Clements, Mark Blackwell, and Gary Jones. Flashy favorite John Desoto, "The Flyin' Hawaiian" will be competing on a CZ.

Lake Whitney Cycle Ranch offers a rough, grueling track of European caliber and is ideally suited for a National Championship Motocross. For spectators the facility is a delight. There is ample camping space at the Ranch, many spots having electrical hook-ups. Located on the Brazos

River just 3 miles below Lake Whitney Dam, Lake Whitney Cycle Ranch has plenty of shade trees lining the track.

Advance tickets are on sale at Central Texas area motorcycle dealers and Sears Roebuck stores in Dallas, Fort Worth and Denton for \$4.50. Tickers at the gate will be \$5, children 6-12, \$2. Races start at 1 p.m., August 12. For information call 813-694-2901 or 214-231-8106.
